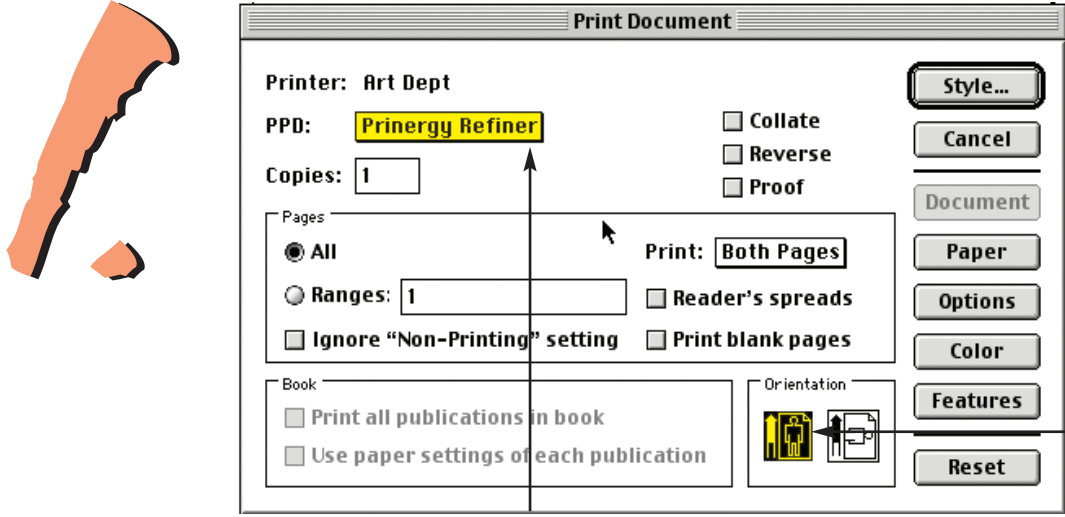


Creating PDFs from *PageMaker*

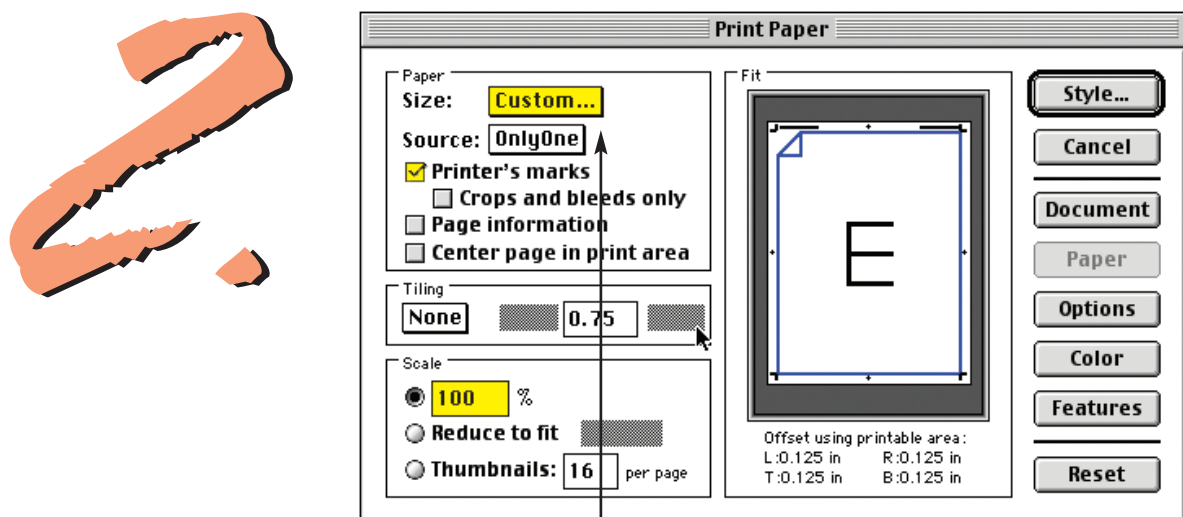
First: Create a Fat Postscript File using the Printer Description (PPD) furnished by CPI.

Begin by going to: File> Print.

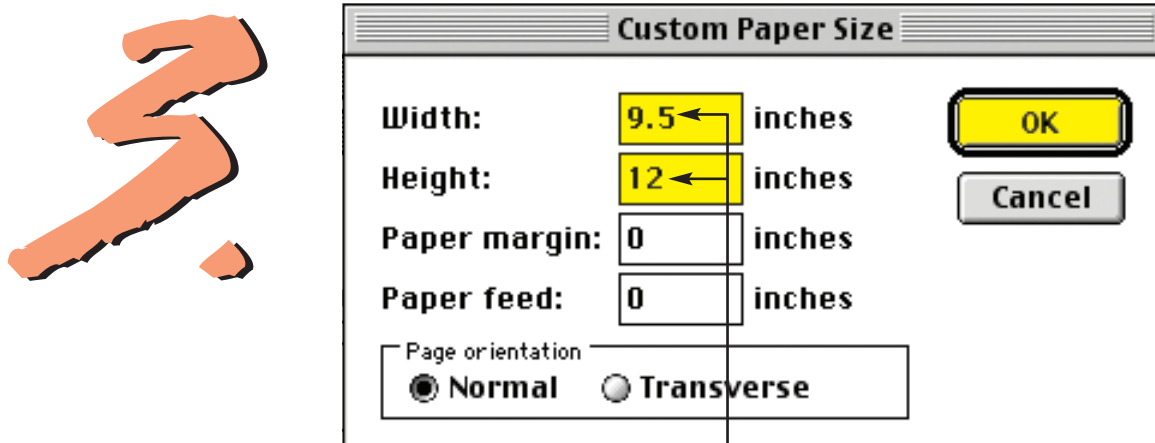


Must be this orientation

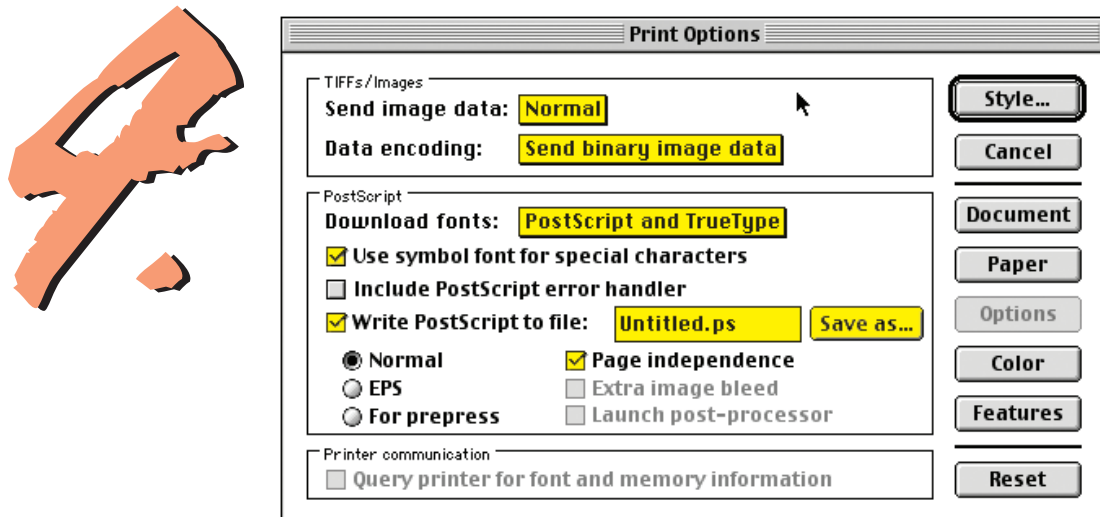
Supplied to you by CPI
(Place PPD file: System Folder> Extensions Folder> Printer Descriptions)



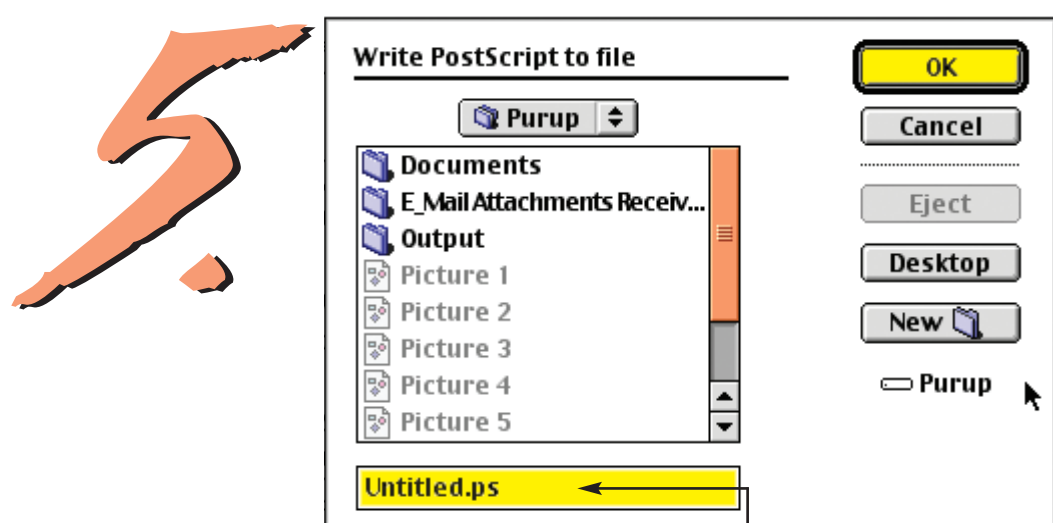
Click on Custom



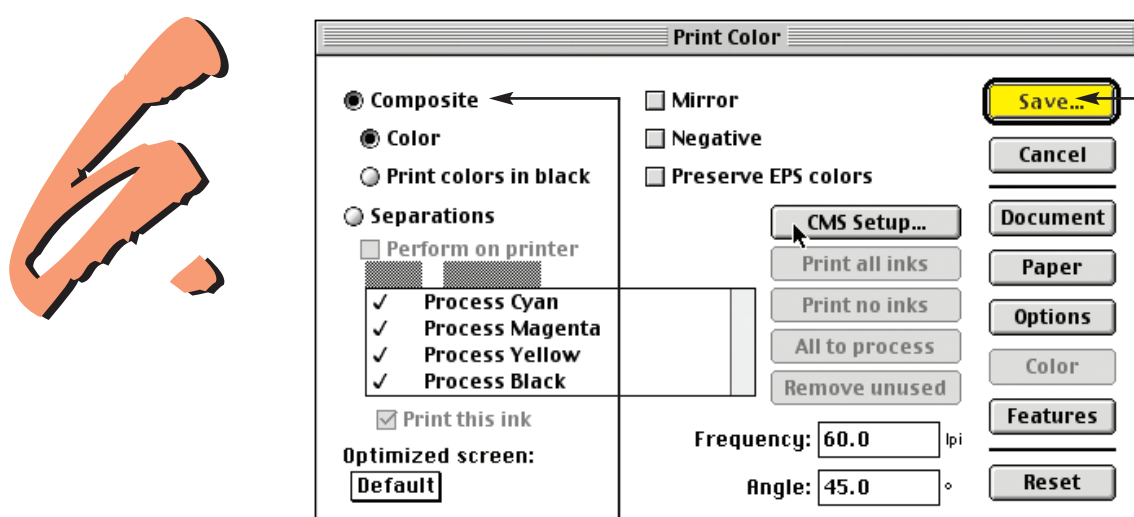
Make 1" bigger than the document size.



Must be these settings



Any name, just keep it short



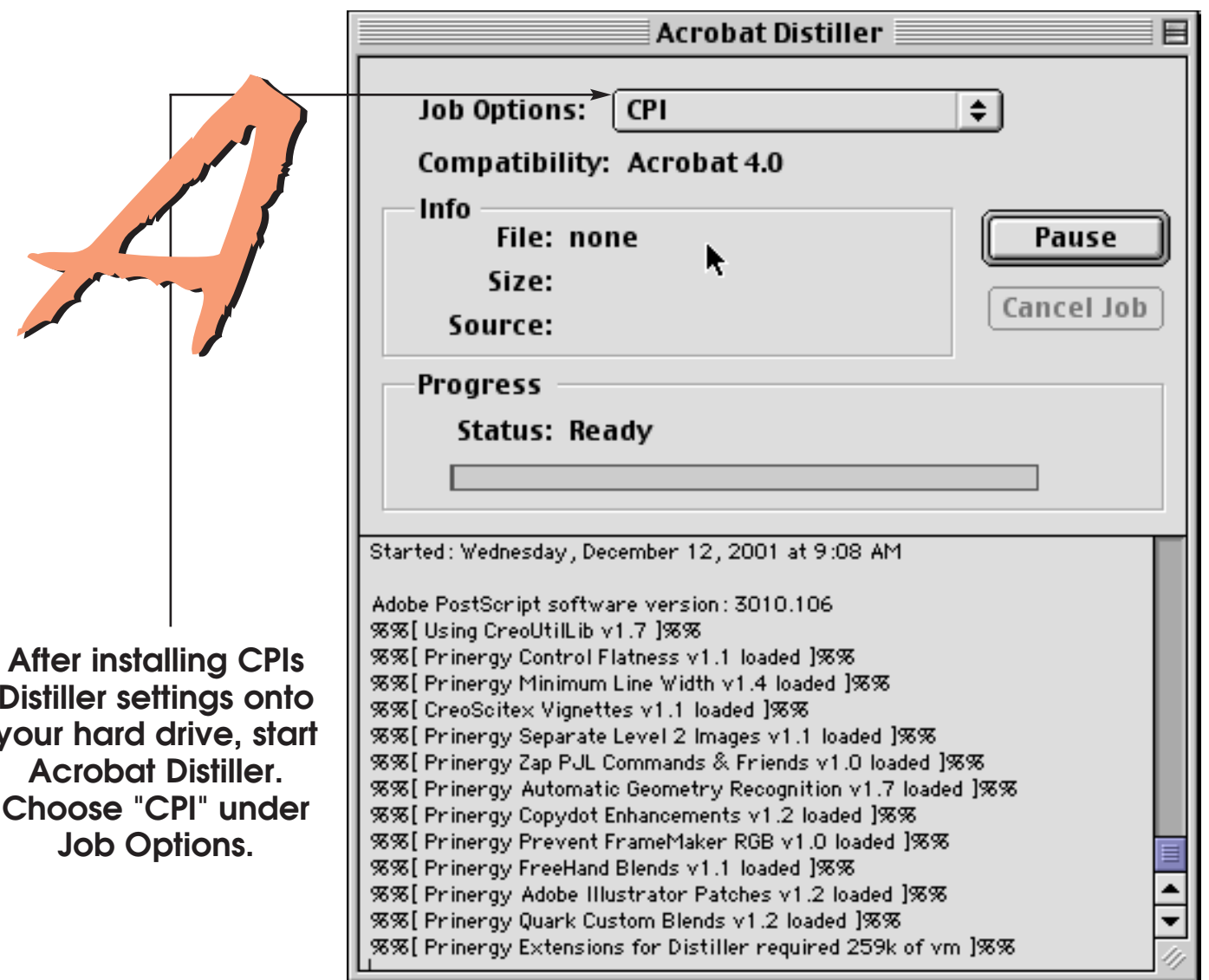
Must be composite color

Just click save. It will write a Fat Composite .ps file with all Fonts and Graphics.

Second: Create a PDF file using the .ps file just created, Acrobat 4.0 and the "Settings" furnished by CPI.

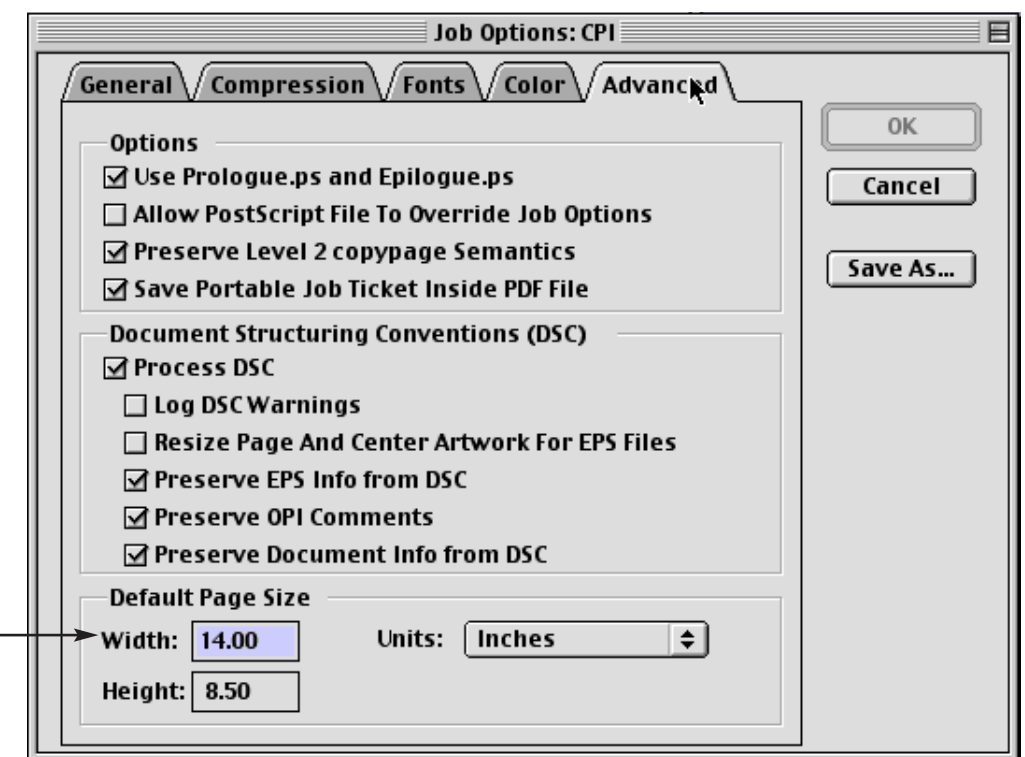
1. Launch Acrobat Distiller*
2. Choose CPI in "Job Options" (see A).
3. See Page Size: Make 1" bigger than trim size (see B).
4. Drag the postscript file onto the Distiller widow. (see A).
5. Send us the resultant .PDF file.

* Be sure you have installed CPI job options first. See C for instructions on how to do this.

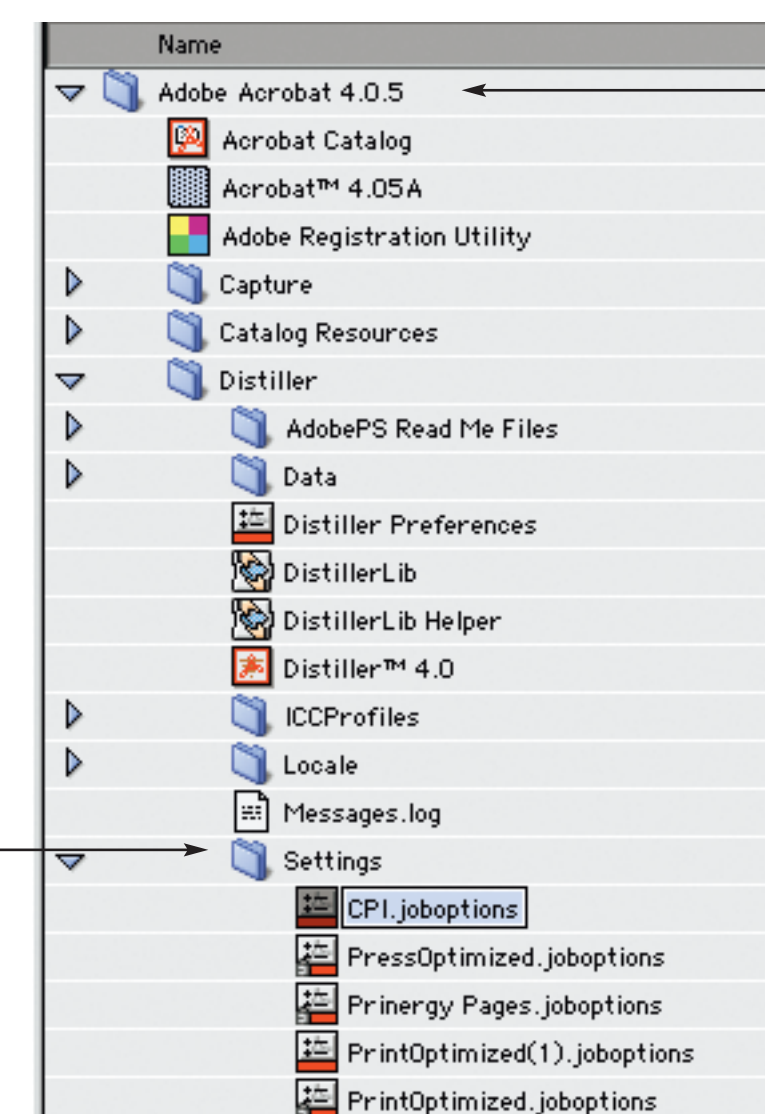
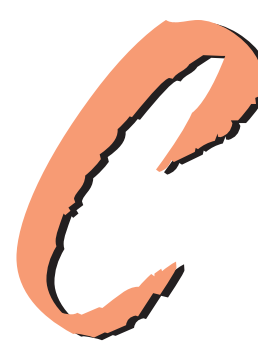


After installing CPIs Distiller settings onto your hard drive, start Acrobat Distiller. Choose "CPI" under Job Options.

CPIs *Acrobat Distiller* Settings



Width and height should be 1" larger than trim size.



Adobe Acrobat - Stored on your hard drive

Place CPIs Distiller settings in the "settings" folder
