## EMERGENCY BACK-UP AND REDUNDANCY PLAN

Coastal Printing has an emergency back-up plan should there be an interruption in our ability to supply printing to our customer base (both short-term and long-term).

1. We back up all of our production art files (daily) onto a redundant server daily and onto hard media twice per week – so our maximum exposure to lost files is one day. All hard media is stored in a fireproof cabinet and a copy is made and kept offsite.
2. We back up all of our MIS files onto hard media and onto a “cloud” solution – this is done daily.
3. All of our servers are operated through surge protected battery back-up power sources.
4. We have a 24/7 contract with Kodak to support all of our Production servers and our Trendsetter Plate maker so that should one of the servers go down or the Plate maker go down we can be operational within one business day.
5. We have 24/7 technician support for repair to all of our press and bindery equipment.
6. We have 24/7 out-sourced IT Service support for all of our MIS, network and local computers.
7. We have created relationships with two printing companies in Florida (one on the west coast and one on the east coast) that have similar production configurations as ours and that are both G7 calibrated so that we can deliver files to them in an emergency situation and they would print for us.
8. We maintain a full list of all employees contact information and have a plan for an offsite location to be able to manage our business should an event occur that would require this.
9. We are members of IPW (Independent Printers Worldwide) and are part of a nationwide network of qualified printing companies that can share work with each other to print and deliver to local geographic markets. IPW has 200+ members in the US & Canada, of which 16 (several in each major geographic region in the US) are part of the print-share network.
